

TURA CIVIL HOSPITAL

I) BRIEF HISTORY ON THE SET UP OF THE HOSPITAL IN THE DISTRICT:

Tura Civil Hospital was just a 30 bedded hospital and was functioning in small set up of Assam type houses located in Lower Babupara, Tura under the establishment of the Civil Surgeon, Garo Hills. The 100 bedded Tura Civil Hospital was constructed in the allotted land in the present location at Dermile in the Tura De-Reserved Forest and inaugurated by the then Hon'ble Chief Minister, Shri. P. A. Sangma on 22-06-1988. An additional building of another 100 bedded hospital was constructed and annexed to the existing hospital making it a 200 bedded hospital. The 100 bedded Additional Building was inaugurated by the then Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister Dr. Mukul Sangma on 14-09-2007. The 200 bedded Tura Civil Hospital is now functioning as a District Hospital providing curative, preventive and promotive healthcare services to the people of the region. It serves as a secondary level hospital as it is the only referral centre for the PHCs / CHCs of the entire region of Garo Hills and adjoining areas of Assam.

II) FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES OF THE HOSPITAL:

The functions of Tura Civil Hospital is to treat all people with care and dignity and provide quality healthcare to all. Tura Civil Hospital is a general district hospital and provides medical, surgical and rehabilitative services to all the patients. It also provides round the clock (24 x 7) emergency services. It provides diagnostic and treatment services through OPD which functions from Monday to Saturday and it has In-patient facilities for those who require admissions for treatment. It also provides counseling services to those who require it.

It also has Female Health Workers Training Institute attached to the Hospital which imparts training to ANMs.
