ADVERTISEMENT FOR AUXILIARY NURSING & MIDWIFERY (A.N.M)
TRAINING SESSION 2018-19

Application in **plain paper** for 2 years course in Auxiliary Nursing & Midwifery (ANM) session 2018-2019 are hereby invited and will be received by the Office of the undersigned and Office of the District Medical & Health Officer, Tura till **6th July, 2018 at 3:00 P.M.**

1. Female unmarried candidates who are indigenous inhabitants or permanent residents of the State are eligible to apply subject to fulfillment of the following criteria:
 - (i) Age: Minimum age for admission will be 17 years as on 31st December 2018.
 - (ii) The upper age limit is 30 yrs.
 - (iii) The minimum educational qualification shall be 10+2 recognized by MBOSE/ CBSE/ ICSE/SSSCE/HSCE or a recognized equivalent examination.
 - (iv) Applicants shall be medically fit.
2. Application which does not fulfill the requirement as per INC will be rejected. No application will be accepted or entertained after the last date of submission.
3. Candidates are required to appear before the Screening Committee which will be held on the **20th & 21st August, 2018** from **10:00 A.M - 5:00 P.M** at Female Health Worker Training School Ganesh Das Govt. MCH Hospital, Shillong and Civil Hospital, Tura. The Applicant will also be medically examined at the same time.
4. The applicants are to bring along with all the relevant documents in originals at the time of Screening.
5. To minimize the delay and hardship to the candidates, screening will be arranged in order of merit and aggregate percentage of marks obtained at the qualifying examination which will be approximately two/three times the number of seats available category-wise.
6. The list of candidates eligible for Screening will be displayed in the Notice Board of the Directorate of Health Services (MI) Shillong, Female Health Worker Training School Ganesh Das Govt. MCH Hospital, Shillong, Office of the District Medical & Health Officer, Tura and Civil Hospital, Tura.
7. Selection of candidates who are medically fit and eligible will be made purely on the basis of merit and subject to reservation policy of the State Government.
8. The list of selected candidates eligible for the course will be displayed on the notice board of DIRECTORATE OF HEALTH SERVICES (MI), SHILLONG and OFFICE OF THE DISTRICT MEDICAL & HEALTH OFFICER, TURA, WEST GARO HILLS. No individual intimation will be served on candidate selected.
9. Selected candidates are to report immediately to the Deputy Director Nursing, Directorate of Health Services (MI) for further instruction as the case may be.
10. Selected candidates who fail to report according to the fixed date will automatically lose their right to nomination and the next eligible candidate from the merit list will be nominated.
11. Candidates are required to submit their application in plain paper with the following particulars:-
 - a) Name in Block Letter.
 - b) Present Address.
 - c) Age as on 31st December, 2018.
 - d) Name of Father/Mother/Guardian with permanent address.
 - e) Schedule Tribe/Schedule Caste/Other Tribe Certificate.
 - f) Proof of Age (SSLC Admit Card or Birth Certificate).
 - g) Mark Sheets of 10+2 Examination passed.
 - h) Character Certificate.
 - i) Aggregate percentage of marks obtained.
 - j) Telephone number (mandatory).

Further, note the Govt. will have no obligation to employ the passed out trainees. Henceforth, as per the INC resolution there will be no Service Bond.
