**ADVERTISEMENT FOR GENERAL NURSING & MIDWIFERY (GNM) AND AUXILIARY
NURSING & MIDWIFERY (A.N.M) TRAINING SESSION 2020-21**

Online Application in prescribed format for 3 year course in General Nursing & Midwifery (GNM) and 2 years course in Auxiliary Nursing & Midwifery (ANM) training session 2020-2021 are hereby invited up to **8th September, 2020** till **3:00 P.M.** For details visit website www.meghealth.gov.in

1. **Eligibility for GNM Training Course:** Male/Female unmarried candidates who are indigenous inhabitants or permanent residents of the State are eligible to apply subject to fulfillment of the following criteria:
 - (i) Age: Minimum age for admission will be 17 years as on 31st December 2020. The upper age limit is 35 yrs and for Registered ANM there is no age bar.
 - (ii) 10+2 level examination with 40% aggregate marks from recognized University/ Board. Candidates are also eligible from the State open School recognized by State government and National Institute of open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government. However Science is preferable.
 - (iii) 10+2 with English having 40% of Marks in Vocational Stream-Health Care Science from recognized CBSE Board/ State/ Centre.
 - (iv) Registered Auxiliary Nurse Midwife (ANM) with 10+2 educational qualification.
 - (v) Disabled Candidates – 3% disability reservation to be considered with a disability of locomotor to the tune of 40% to 50% of lower extremity after thoroughly examined and certified by Medical & Health Officer.
2. **Eligibility for ANM Training Course:** Female unmarried candidates who are indigenous inhabitants or permanent residents of the State are eligible to apply subject to fulfillment of the following criteria:
 - (i) Age: Minimum age for admission will be 17 years as on 31st December 2020.
 - (ii) The upper age limit is 30 yrs.
 - (iii) The minimum educational qualification shall be 10+2 recognized by MBOSE/ CBSE/ ICSE/SSSCE/HSCE or a recognized equivalent examination.
 - (iv) Applicants shall be medically fit.
3. Application which does not fulfill the requirement as per INC will be rejected. No application will be accepted or entertained after the last date of submission.
4. The list of candidates eligible for Screening will be displayed in the website above.
5. The date of screening will be intimated later.
6. Selection of candidates who are medically fit and eligible will be made purely on the basis of merit and subject to reservation policy of the State Government.
7. The list of selected candidates eligible for the undergoing the course will be displayed on the notice board of DIRECTORATE OF HEALTH SERVICES (MI), SHILLONG and OFFICE OF THE DISTRICT MEDICAL & HEALTH OFFICER, TURA, WEST GARO HILLS and in Government website. No individual intimation will be served on candidate selected.
8. Selected candidates are to report immediately to the Deputy Director Nursing, Directorate of Health Services (MI) for further instruction as the case may be.
9. Selected candidates who fail to report according to the fixed date will automatically lose their right to nomination and the next eligible candidate from the merit list will be nominated.

Further, note the Govt. will have no obligation to employ the passed out trainees. Henceforth, as per the INC resolution there will be no Service Bond.
