ADVERTISEMENT FOR B.Sc. NURSING AGAINST STATE QUOTA SEATS

Online Application in prescribed format for B.Sc. Nursing against State Quota seats for Academic Session 2025-26 is hereby invited only from candidates who appeared the State Common Entrance Examination, 2025. The online application form will commence from 12th July, 2025 at 10:00 A.M up to 26th July 2025 till 5:00 P.M. Application form without the State CEE 2025 Score Sheet will not be considered under any circumstances.No application will be accepted or entertained after the last date of submission.For further details, interested candidates may visit website www.meghealth.gov.in

1. Eligibility Criteria:-

- i. **Only candidates who are indigenous inhabitants of the State** and have who have passed the qualifying 12th Standard examination (10+2) and must have obtained a minimum of 45% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together and passed in English individually.
- ii. Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government having Science and English only.
- iii. English is a compulsory subject in 10+2 for being eligible for applying the CEE for admission to B.Sc. (Nursing).
- iv. Candidates must obtain the desired percentile cut-off score in the State Common Entrance Examination 2025 as declared by this Directorate vide No. DHSME&R/Estt/CEE/2025/2/4729 Dated Shillong, the 7th July, 2025.
- v. Age: Candidates should complete the age of 17 years on or before 31st December, 2025. The upper age limit shall be 35 years as on 31st December, 2025.
- vi. Colour blind candidates are eligible provided that colour corrective contact lens and spectacles are worn by such candidates.
- vii. Candidates should be medically fit.

2. Selection of Candidates:

- i. EligibleCandidates who are otherwise medically fit will be ranked on merit as per their State CEE score in their respective categories as declared by this Directorate.
- ii. Final selection of eligible candidates shall subject to Reservation Policy of the State of Meghalaya.
- iii. In every case where two or more candidates obtained the same percentile in the entrance examination, then the merit of such tie will be resolved as stated below:
 - a) Candidates obtaining higher percentile score in Biology in the CEE will be considered.
 - b) If the ties still persist, then candidates obtaining higher percentile score in Chemistry in the CEE will be considered.
 - c) Further, if the ties still persist, then candidates obtaining higher percentile score in Physics in the CEE will be considered.
 - d) Furthermore, if ties still persist, then candidates obtaining higher percentile score in English in the CEE will be considered.
 - e) If the ties still persist even after considering the above, then the date of birth of the candidates will be taken into account whereby a candidate older in age will be placed higher on the Merit List.
- iv. The list of candidates eligible for appearing the screening/counseling along with Centre and the date for screening/counseling will be displayed in the website above.

3. Final list of Selected Candidates:

- 1) The Final Selection of Candidates will be ranked as per the State CEE score in their respective categories.
- 2) The names of theCandidates selected for nomination and the waiting list for each category will be displayed in the Notice Board of the Directorate of the Health Services, Medical Education & Research (DME), Shillong/ Office of the District Medical & Health Officer, Tura West Garo Hills and in the Government Website. It will also be published in the local dailies published from Shillong and Tura. All applicants are required to ascertain the nomination from the above sources. NO INDIVIDUAL INTIMATION WILL BE SERVED ON ANY APPLICANTS SELECTED FOR NOMINATION.
- 3) Candidates whose names are included in the final selected list for the nomination and published as above are required to report to the Deputy Secretary/ Under Secretary to the Government of Meghalaya, Health & Family Welfare Department, Room No. 506, Additional Secretariat Building within the date and time indicated at the time ofnotifying the list of selected candidates. They should personally submit their letter of acceptance and to collect their letter of nomination for further instruction, as the case may be. ANY SELECTED CANDIDATES, WHO FAILS TO REPORT ACCORDING TO THE FIXED DATE AS SPECIFIED ABOVE, WILL AUTOMATICALLY LOSE HIS OR HER RIGHT TO NOMINATION AND THE NEXT ELIGIBLE CANDIDATE FROM THE WAITING LIST WILL BE NOMINATED.
- 4) Terms and condition for admission and all other requirements including recurring fees of the concerned Medical Institution to which the applicant is nominated will have to be abided and paid by the applicant concerned in time and the responsibility on this count shall rest with the candidate/student.
- 4. **METHODOLOGY FOR SELECTION OF CANDIDATES:**Counseling will be done to eligible candidates who are shortlisted and seats will be allocated while adhering to the following rules:
 - a) For the Open Category, the seats will be allotted solely on merit.
 - b) For all other categories, including Khasi & Jaintia, Garo, SC and OST, the seats will be equitably allocated to each category as per category rank. In the first round, all the first rankers in each category will be allocated a seat. IN the second round, all the second rankers will be allocated seats and this process will be repeated until the seats are exhausted.
