Online Application in prescribed format for Medical Studies i.e. **(1) MBBS (2) BDS (3) BHMS (4) BAMS (5) BUMS** against State Quota seats in various Medical Institutions in India during Academic Session 2026-2027 is hereby invited with effect from **6th August 2026 to 16th August 2026 (till 5:00 PM)**. Eligibility for Medical Studies:-

1. Only candidates who are **indigenous inhabitants or Permanent Residents of the State** and have passed 10+2 level examination from a recognized University or Board of Authority in the subjects of **Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Biotechnology and English and qualifying NEET UG 2026** are eligible to apply.
2. For the purpose of permanent residency status in respect of admission in higher education institutions, the instructions of Political Department including Order No. POL. 97/74/174 dated 10th June 1983 and No. POL.97/74/Pt-1/221 dated 21st March 2014 shall be referred to.
3. They should complete the age of 17 years on or before 31st December, 2026.
4. No upper age limit.
5. Applicants should be medically fit.
6. Application Form without **NEET UG 2026 (RESULT SHEET)** will not be considered under any circumstances.
7. **No application will be accepted or entertained after the last date of submission.**
8. **Selection of candidates:**
 - (i) Candidates who are otherwise medically fit and eligible will be ranked on merit as per their NEET Score in their respective categories.
 - (ii) In respect of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes, the minimum marks shall be with reference to marks secured by candidates in the respective categories.

(iii) Final selection of eligible candidates shall be subject to Reservation Policy of the State of Meghalaya.

9. The list of candidates eligible for screening / counselling will be displayed in the website above.

10. The date for screening / counselling will be notified later in the Government website.

11. **Final list of applicants:**

(i) The candidates will be ranked on merit as per their NEET score but in their respective categories.

(ii) The names of candidates selected for nomination and the waiting list for each category will be displayed in the Notice Board of the Directorate of Health Services Medical Education & Research (DME), Meghalaya, Shillong / Office of the District Medical & Health Officer, Tura, West Garo Hills and in the Government website. It will also be published in the local dailies published from Shillong and Tura. All applicants are required to ascertain the nominations from the above sources. **NO INDIVIDUAL INTIMATION WILL BE SERVED ON ANY APPLICANT SELECTED FOR NOMINATION.**

12. Applicants whose names are included in the list selected for the nomination and published as above are required to report to the Director of Health Services Medical Education & Research (DME) within the date and time to be indicated while publishing the list of selected candidates and personally submit their letter of acceptance, execute Surety Bond for the value of Rs.30,00,000/- (Rupees Thirty Lakhs) only (in case of MBBS Course) with 5 (five) years Rural service according to the Categories and to collect their letter of nominations for further instructions, as the case may be. **ANY SELECTED APPLICANT, WHO FAILS TO REPORT ACCORDING TO THE FIXED DATE AS SPECIFIED ABOVE, WILL AUTOMATICALLY LOSE HIS OR HER RIGHT TO NOMINATION AND THE NEXT ELIGIBLE CANDIDATE FROM THE WAITING LIST WILL BE NOMINATED.**

13. Terms and conditions for admission and all other requirements including recurring fees of the concerned Medical Institution to which the applicant is nominated will have to be abided and paid by the applicant concerned in time and the responsibility on this count shall rest with the candidate / student.

14. **All** candidates intending to apply for the counselling **MUST COMPLETE THE ONLINE APPLICATION** by submitting the application form through the website www.meghealth.gov.in

15. Declaration and Verification of application details:

(i) All entries in the online application form must be filled in by the candidate with utmost care and diligence. The candidate shall be solely responsible for the correctness and accuracy of all information provided, including academic marks, category status, and enclosures uploaded or submitted.

(ii) Candidates are hereby informed that the information furnished in the application form, including marks obtained in the qualifying examination and supporting documents, shall be subject to verification and scrutiny by the concerned authorities.

If, at any stage of the admission process or during the course of study, it is found that any information or document submitted by the candidate is false, fabricated, or incorrect, then:

- a. The admission shall stand cancelled forthwith, irrespective of the stage of the course at that time.
- b. The candidate shall be debarred from seeking admission to any course under the State Government quota for a period of three years;
- c. Appropriate legal and/or criminal proceedings shall be initiated against the candidate and, where applicable, their parents/guardian, for submission of fraudulent documents such as Meghalaya ST/SC/OST and Permanent Resident Certificates.
