The Director of Health Services Medical Education & Research (DME), Government of Meghalaya invites **Online Application** for appearing the Common Entrance Examination (CEE)from interested candidates who desire to pursue admission for General Nursing & Midwifery (GNM) and Auxiliary Nurse & Midwives (ANM) Course Session 2026-27 for **State Government Quota**. - Candidates can apply for CEE for General Nursing & Midwifery (GNM) and Auxiliary Nurse & Midwives (ANM) Course Session 2026-27 through the “**Online**” mode only on the website www.meghealth.gov.in.
- The Application Form in any other mode will not be accepted.
- Only one application is to be submitted by a candidate.
- Applicants must register themselves in the Online Portal, if previously not registered. Those who are already registered may login directly using their registered email Id and password.
- When Candidates register/ submit the fees, they have to enter the OTP received on their registered Mobile Number.
- Candidates must strictly follow the instructions given in the Advertisement and in the website. Candidates not complying with the instructions shall be summarily disqualified.
- Candidates must ensure that the e-mail address and mobile number provided in the Online Application Form are their own and/or Parents/Guardians only as all information/ communication will be sent through e-mail on the registered e-mail address.

SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

- Syllabus of the Examination**– The Question will be purely from the following subjects:

Sl. No.	SUBJECTS	MARKS
1.	English	50 Marks
2.	Basic Mathematics	25 Marks
3.	General Science	25 Marks

2. **Mode of Examination** – The CEE is a Pen & Paper-based Test, to be answered on the specially designed machine gradable OMR sheet using Ball Point Pen. Moreover, tampering with the OMR response sheet at any stage will lead to declaration of candidates as unsuccessful.
3. **Pattern of the Examination** –
 - a) **The Maximum marks for the Written Examination will be 100 marks.**
 - b) Questions will be in **Multiple Choice Questions.**
 - c) Each question will carry **1 mark.**
 - d) There will be **NO NEGATIVE MARKING** for attempt of questions.
 - e) Only one circle should be darkened while attempting a correct answer. If more than 1 circle is darkened for the answer of a question, it will be deemed as incorrect.
 - f) Candidates are to use only **BLACK BALL POINT PEN** for darkening the OMR Sheet.
4. **Medium of the Question Papers** – The CEE will be in English medium.
5. **Centres:** There will be two separate Centres for writing the Examination, i.e. at **Shillong** and **Tura.**

ELGIBILITY AND QUALIFICATION

1. Only candidates who are Bonafide citizens of Meghalaya are eligible to apply for appearing the State CEE for GNM/ANM.
2. Age: Minimum age for admission shall be 17 years as on or before 31st December of the year in which admission is sought.
3. **Minimum education eligibility criteria for admission to GNM/ANM:**
 - i. 10+2 with English and must have obtained a minimum of 40% at the qualifying examination and English individually from any recognized board. Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government. Three (core elective) subjects may be taken for calculating the percentage of marks excluding the marks in English. Also, it has to be ensured that the candidates have pass marks in English. However, 5% of total marks is relaxed for SC/ST candidates.
 - ii. 10+2 with English having 40% marks in vocational ANM course/Registered ANM from the school recognized by Indian Nursing Council for GNM course
 - iii. 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in Vocational Stream-Health care Science from recognized CBSE board/State/Centre.
 - iv. Admission is subject to satisfactory medical examination report.
 - v. Admission for ANM is restricted only for female candidates.
 - vi. Reservation policy for disability as per INC guidelines.

SELECTION PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION

- i. The marks obtained by all appearing candidates along with the list of candidates eligible for appearing the counselling for admission to the course will be displayed in the Government website at www.meghealth.gov.in.
- ii. Admission to GNM/ANM Course under State Government Quota will be based purely on merit of the State Common Entrance Examination written exam and as per the State Reservation Policy.
- iii. Admission to GNM will be given as first priority based on merit followed by admission to ANM course as per eligibility and Qualification criteria.

VALIDITY OF THE ELIGIBILITY MERIT LIST

The State Common Entrance Examination eligibility merit list declared by the conducting authority shall be valid for the **current academic session only**, for which the Common Entrance Examination is being conducted.

Further, note the Govt. will have no obligation to employ the passed-out trainees. Henceforth, as per the INC resolution, there will be no Service Bond.
