However, they must secure the 45% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology taken together and passed in English in the 12th standard (10+2) Science Examination whenever the result of the same is declared.

Candidates who failed to secure the percentage of marks as described above shall be disqualified by the concerned admitting authority where they seek their B.Sc. Nursing Course admission irrespective of their CEE Score.
