APPLICATIONS FOR THE MEGHALAYA MEDICAL ENTRANCE TEST, 2014- 15

In pursuance of Government of India letter No. 14014/2/2014-ME-IV dated 27.02.2014 Applications are invited in prescribed form for Entrance Test i.e. MBBS/BDS against State Quota of seats in various Medical Institutions for Courses commencing during 2014-15 are hereby invited and will be received in the Office of the Director of Health Services(MI), Shillong and District Medical & Health Officer, West Garo Hills District, Tura. (N.B. Application form will be issued from 28th May, 2014 in the above offices).

- 1. Only candidates who are indigenous inhabitants or permanent residents of the State and have passed 10+2 level securing marks 45% or above in PCB in aggregate from a recognized University, Board of Authority with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English. However, candidates appearing in such examinations and awaiting results can also apply. However, and subject to production of a Permanent Resident Certificate,
 - (i) the Children of the Employees of the Central Government, other State/ UT Government who are on deputation to Meghalaya and
 - (ii) the Children of the employees of the Central Government, all India Services, other State/ UT Government posted in and having Headquarter within Meghalaya will also be eligible to apply, provided they fulfill conditions at 1 above.
- 2. Candidates applying for MBBS/BDS Course should complete the age of 17 years at the time of admission or will complete the age on or before the 31st December of the year of his/her admission to 1st Year MBBS/BDS Course and the upper age limit is 25 years as on 31st December of the year of the Entrance Test provided that the upper age limit is relaxable by 5 years in the case of ST/SC Candidate.
- 3. Selection of candidates who are otherwise medically fit and eligible will be made as follows:-
 - 60% will be from the Entrance Test
 - 40% will be taken from the 10+2 Science (PCB)/ Board/ISC/CBSE/ other qualifying Examination.
 - After which a combine merit marks i.e. 40% weightage for performance in CI-XII
 (PCB)/ Board/ISC/CBSE/ other qualifying Examination and 60% weightage from the
 Entrance Test will be taken and a combine merit list would be decided accordingly.
 - The State Reservation Policy will be applicable as usual.

Application Form may be obtained from the office of the Director of Health Services (MI), Meghalaya, Shillong and the DM & HO, West Garo Hills, Tura against submission/production of a crossed Indian Postal order/Demand Draft (Nationalised Bank) of Rs. 250/-(Rupees Two hundred and fifty) only and Rs. 100/- (Rupees one hundred) only in the case of ST/SC payable to the Director of Health Services (MI), Meghalaya, Shillong.

HOWEVER COMPLETED APPLICATION FORMS WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED IN THE OFFICE OF THE DIRECTOR OF HEALTH SERVICES (MI) AT SHILLONG AND THE DISTRICT MEDICAL & HEALTH OFFICER, WEST GARO HILLS, TURA.

- Application Form received after 3:00 PM on Monday 16th June, 2014 will not be considered under any circumstances including postal delay.
- 6. Admit Cards to the Entrance Test will be issued from the Office of the Director of Health Services (MI), Meghalaya, Shillong & District Medical & Health Officer, West Garo Hills, Tura from the 1st July, 2014 to the 7th July, 2014.
- 7. ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS ARE REQUIRED TO APPEAR BEFORE A SCREENING COMMITTEE FOR VERIFICATION OF ORIGINAL COPIES OF 10 AND 10+2 ADMIT CARDS, MARK SHEETS, ST/SC CERTIFICATE, PERMANENT RESIDENTIAL CERTIFICATE (PRC), CHARACTER CERTIFICATE FROM INSTITUTION LAST ATTENDED AND CERTIFICATE OF HAVING PASSED THE QUALIFYING EXAMINATION IN SCIENCE STREAM AT THE TIME OF APPEARING THE INTERVIEW OF SCREENING. ALL THE ORIGINAL CERTIFICATES MENTIONED SHOULD BE MADE AVAILABLE. THE APPLICANTS WILL ALSO HAVE TO APPEAR BEFORE THE MEDICAL BOARD. DATES TO BE NOTIFIED LATER.
- 8. The final list of applicants selected for nomination under all categories and the waiting list for each such category will be published in the Notice Board of the Directorate of Health Services (MI). it will also be published in the local dailies published from Shillong and Tura. All applicants are required to ascertain the nominations from the above sources. NO INDIVIDUAL INTIMATION WILL BE SERVED ON ANY APPLICANT SELECTED FOR NOMINATION.
- 9. Applicants whose names are included in the list selected for the nomination and published as above are required to report to the Secretary to the Govt. of Meghalaya, Health & Family Welfare Department, Room No. 411, Additional Secretariat Building within the date and time to be indicated while publishing the list of selected candidates and personally submit their letter of acceptance, execute Surety Bond for the value of Rs. 25,00,000/-(Rupees Twenty Five Lakhs) only (in case of MBBS Course) and to collect their letter of nominations or further instructions, as the case may be. The last date for admission to different Medical Institutions will be notified through the Notice Board and Notice published in

the above named Newspaper in due course. ANY SELECTED APPLICANT, WHO FAILS TO REPORT ACCORDING TO THE FIXED DATE AS SPECIFIED ABOVE, WILL AUTOMATICALLY LOSE HIS OR HER RIGHT TO NOMINATION AND THE NEXT ELIGIBLE CANDIDATE FROM THE WAITING LIST WILL BE NOMINATED.

- 10. The SECOND LIST OF NOMINATION whose names will be drawn from the waiting list will likewise be published in the Notice Board and in prominent Newspapers. Waiting List Candidates are required to ascertain the position from the above sources and take further steps accordingly. NO INDIVIDUAL INTIMATION WILL BE SERVED.
- 11. The list of selected candidates will be available in the Meghalaya Government Website, i.e. www. meghalaya.nic.in.
- 12. Terms and conditions for admission and all other requirements including recurring fees of the concerned Medical Institution to which the applicant is nominated will have to be abided and paid by the applicant concerned in time and the responsibility on this count shall rest with the candidate.
